The Cheshire and Warrington Data and Labour Market Steering Group have commissioned this work which takes the qualification pathways that have been developed by the Institute for Apprenticeships and Technical Education, mapping different occupations against them and contextualising them for the Cheshire and Warrington economy.

Cheshire and Warrington Briefing: Hospitality Pathway

Hospitality jobs in Cheshire and Warrington²

- In 2021, there were about 44k of these jobs in Cheshire and Warrington³.
- About 10k of these jobs were below Level 2, 31k were at Level 2, 2k were at Level 3 and 1k were at Level 4+.
- Over the next ten years, about a third of these jobs will need to be filled by new entrants because of retirements and similar.
- Cleaners and Domestics, Kitchen and Catering Assistants, Waiters and Waitresses, and Bar Staff have a high risk of automation in the future, other roles are much less at risk of automation
- There are slightly fewer jobs like this in Cheshire and Warrington than would be expected from the national average.

Age profile of Hospitality jobs

The age profile of employees in Catering jobs is younger than is the case for all jobs.





Job postings⁴

- In the last five years, there have been about 27k unique job postings for this type of job in C&W (excluding staffing companies) with about 12k in Cheshire West and Chester, 10k in Cheshire East, and 5k in Warrington.
- These jobs were mainly advertised in Chester (5,952); Warrington (4,323); Crewe (2,171); Macclesfield (2,039); Northwich (2,019); Ellesmere Port (1,198); Wilmslow (1,111); Knutsford (1,096); and Nantwich (736).
- Top recruiters in Cheshire and Warrington (excluding staffing agencies) include Mitchells & Butlers, J D Wetherspoon, Brunning & Price, NHS, Whitbread, McDonald's, Pizza Hut Restaurants, and Britannia Hotels.
- The most frequently advertised job titles in Cheshire and Warrington are for Cleaners, Receptionists, Cleaning Operatives, Kitchen Assistants, Kitchen Porters, Team Members, Wait Staff, Bar Staff, and Catering Assistants.



Apprenticeships

In the past five years, there have been 452 apprenticeships advertised in Hospitality occupations in Cheshire and Warrington. These were advertised in most parts of Cheshire and Warrington and were mostly for apprentice bar staff and receptionists.

In 2019/20, there were 106 apprenticeship starts in Hospitality jobs. The number of opportunities will have been depressed by the pandemic. Half of these opportunities were at Level 2 and half were at Level 3 and above.

College Courses

The main route into hospitality careers for young people is through apprenticeships. Therefore, there were relatively few classroom-based courses in hospitality and most of those were at Level 1.
