Item 7a: Investment programme update

Overall, the EZ investment programme has reduced from £16.2m committed investment from the LEP to just over £12m, due to a number of investments coming in lower than anticipated in their business cases and the withdrawal of the Aviator

Phase 2 scheme. Note that the Aviator Phase 2 scheme will proceed without the requirement for LEP investment. This leaves c. 18m remaining in the EZ borrowing facility. A claim for £210,514 was received for Blocks 22-24 at Alderley Park in the last period, leaving £2.6m to be drawn down for the scheme and the investment programme overall.

Item 7b: Investment pipeline

- Aviator Phase 2 (Hooton Park) Redsun Developments has appointed Caddick Construction to construct a total of 280,000 sq ft of new industrial floorspace, a 200,000 sq ft unit and an 80,000 sq ft unit, which is due to complete in Summer 2022. The scheme is being funded through Arrow Capital and Cerberus Capital Management. Based on the Phase 1 scheme, we can expect c.£460k in retained business rates annually from the Phase 2 scheme.
- Enviroo (Protos) previously known as ASD, have secured planning permission for the development and have informed us that they are ready to move forward with the project. The Growth Director met with the company in August and the submission of revised investment case is expected for the November Board.
- Waste to Hydrogen Plant (Protos) in discussions with Peel regarding a potential investment in a Waste to Hydrogen Plant. Have issued an investment case template. No estimated timescale for submission at this stage.
- Quadrant Phase 3 (Birchwood Park) discussions ongoing with Patrizia about a potential investment in Quadrant Phase 3, which would see the development of an 85,000 sq ft pre-let in conjunction with the development of 3 speculative units totalling 67,650 sq ft. Submission of investment case expected for November Board.
- Newport Business Park met with Gaerwen Properties to discuss an investment case for the development of the remainder of Newport Business Park. Submission of investment case expected for November Board.
- Thornton Science Park the Growth Director met with CBRE and University of Chester to discuss the procurement of an investment partner and has provided details of the EZ investment model and processes for inclusion in their prospectus/data room.

Item 8: High Speed Growth Corridor
