

Microsoft Power Platform and Process Automation 4 week – Full-Time

Overview of the course:

Our Microsoft Power Platform and Process Automation Skills Bootcamp is a 4-week, full time course.

It focusses on Power Platform which is a suite of low-code and no-code tools that enable businesses to rapidly build and deploy applications, automate workflows and analyse data.

The course will explore the following components:

Power Apps: A low-code application development platform that allows users to create custom applications without writing code.

Power Automate: A workflow automation tool that allows users to automate repetitive tasks and processes. Dataverse – Basic database and Dataverse concepts. Data security and compliance.

You will:

- Understand the fundamentals of Power Platform and its applications.
- Navigate and utilise the Microsoft Power Platform
- Design and develop automated workflows using Power Automate
- Troubleshoot and optimize RPA processes
- Implement RPA solutions within their organisation

We deliver not only a technical curriculum but also include the wider interpersonal and employability skills employers are looking for in the industry. You will develop and build on your communication, problem solving, project collaboration, presentation, and leadership skills.

Throughout the course you will have the opportunity to hear from industry speakers and receive personalised coaching from experienced data, technology and change professionals.
