Delivery & Assessment

You will undertake a series of theoretical and practical assessments with your courses tutor whilst building a professional portfolio of evidence. If you are currently working within a security management role, your tutor/assessor may visit you in your place of work. If you are currently seeking employment, NGTC will provide a practical work placement to complete this course

For candidates seeking employment, you will also be guaranteed an interview with one of our employers.
